1 Annual General Meeting

The Old Paulians' Association ("The Association") held its 91st Annual General Meeting ("AGM") on 26th March at 11.00 a.m. at St. Paul's Institution (Secondary), Jalan Manickavasagam, 70200 Seremban with a turnout of 33 members. The quorum required as per rule 9.5 of OPA's constitution was 20.

(ii) MaLEC(Malaysian Lasallian Educators Conference).

The OPA was given the task to host the 7th Malaysian Lasallian Educators Conference. It is to be organised by the Regional Lasallian Education Council (Southern Zone) in collaboration with St Paul's Institution primary and secondary as well as the Old Paulians' Association.

Under the Chairmanship of Prof. Dr Ganakumaran Subramaniam, a meeting was held and decided to have it in early 2018 due to time constraint. The goal of MaLEC is to bring together all Lasallian schools and their associated organisations to participate from the conference, each other and to build a strong community of institutions that reflect high quality of Lasallian education. B Mr Steven Chan Weng Choy – (Sports Committee)

The Association is affiliated to Negeri Sembilan Badminton Association, Persatuan Badminton Daerah Seremban (represented by Mr Lee Nam Yew) and the Negeri Sembilan Hockey Association (represented by Mr Subramaniam Rathnam).

Paulians' Sports Fund:

From an anonymous donor from the Class of 1985, the Paulian Sports Fund is for the Badminton, Hockey & Basketball training programmes to a higher level for both schools.

With this funding, the 2 schools were able to hire qualified and experienced coaches. The fund is also used to pay for venue rentals, transportation for players participating in competitions. However, the fund had ceased coming in August 2017. In spite of this, a few passionate coaches continued with their coaching in both schools.

<u>Hockey:</u> (Primary school): MSSD Seremban 1, we were runners-up. As in MSSNS, 5 of our players represented the State team and emerged Champions and in MSSM the team got 3RD placing and 5 players received the 'Anugerah Insan Terbilang'. As for SPI indoor hockey, our team emerged runners-up.
